

Daphne Utilities is in the process of submitting applications for both a drinking water state revolving fund (DWSRF) loan and a clean water state revolving fund (CWSRF) loan through the Alabama Department of Environmental Management (ADEM). Both the DWSRF and CWSRF are low interest loan programs for public infrastructure improvements in Alabama. The DWSRF supports infrastructure utilized in treatment of drinking water and providing drinking water to customers while the CWSRF supports infrastructure for the collection and treatment of sewage from customers. As part of the application process, Daphne Utilities prepares an Environmental Information Document (EID) and conducts a public meeting. Due to recent concerns with COVID-19, the public meeting will be held via a conference call on Monday, June 1st at noon.
